
Calendar Raffles



Raffle Ticket Pricing Guide

How to Place an Order:

1. Indicate ticket size and paper color.

- · 24# Bond is a little heavier than copy machine paper.
- 67# Vellum Bristol is a card stock similar to a postcard.
- Ticket sizes are 2-1/8 x 5.5", 2.2 x 7.5", or 2 3/4 x 7 ~ 8.5" Other sizes can be produced, these just happen to be the most economical for you in terms of material usage.

Standard paper colors are: Blue, Green, Yellow, Orchid, and Gold

Note: Or	chid is now o	only available	e in 67# vellu	m bristol.

Astrobright colors are also available for a slight up-charge.

2. Indicate the quantity you need.

- 3. Email, Fax or send in your copy. It is not necessary for you to worry about laying out your ticket. Except for Calendar Raffle Tickets, there is no charge for typesetting. Depending on the number of months displayed, the up-charge for Calendar Tickets is between \$18 \$35. Sending raw text in an email message is just fine.
- 4. On all orders, a proof will be returned for your final approval. Note any corrections necessary & return the proof. It is a very good practice to have an extra set of eyes go over the proof. You, as the author, will always have the last word ... okaying the proof.

5. OK the proof & authorize the order.

Note any corrections necessary & return the proof via email, fax or regular mail.

6. Tickets are shipped via USPS Priority Mail or, in the Midwest (Wisconsin, Michigan, Illinois, Iowa, Missouri, Minnesota, N & S Dakota, Nebraska), via Speedee Delivery.

Booklet Stapling

Determine the total number of raffle books you want to end up with and multiply by \$0.029. For books of less than 4 sheets ... using 24# bond, multiply by \$0.045 ... using 67# vellum bristol, multiply by \$0.035. For books of more than 7 sheets, multiply by \$0.045.

How long does it take to ship tickets?

Normally we try to have a proof back to you the same day. Once the proof is OKed, turnaround time for orders under 25,000 is normally 1-3 days depending on how many orders are in production. Larger orders may take longer. We appreciate it when you order well in advance of your distribution plans.

Which paper stock should you choose?

In most cases this will be obvious to you. But bear in mind that the 24# bond stock is most appropriately used when tickets are stapled in books of 6 tickets/book or more. Tickets printed on 67# vellum bristol stock are definitely a better product in singles or in books of less than 6 but you will have to determine if your budget needs to play a part in your decision.

Just so you know ...

Quite often I get phone inquiries asking me to check pricing on a certain type of raffle ticket order. The person is usually looking at my price list, just as you are right now. Most of the time. the call is prompted because the pricing looks too low. The caller knows what they paid on previous orders and can't quite reconcile my pricing, thinking there must be something wrong. When this happens I have to smile and explain that in the past, they probably were charged a fair price since printers typically charge on a time & material basis. I have tried very hard to put together production equipment which allows me to have production capabilities many times what most printers can justify for their raffle ticket orders. Since I can do more in a day, I can pass on the savings to my customers. It's just a matter of scale.
